Executive Summary

The University of Missouri Local Section hosted the 38th Midwest Regional Meeting of the American Chemical Society. Attendance at the meeting totaled more than 557. The meeting was held at the Memorial Union on the University of Missouri-Columbia campus on Wednesday, November 5 through Friday, November 7, 2003, with the Midwest Regional Meeting Awards Banquet being held at the Reynolds Alumni Center on Thursday, November 6. The Midwest Regional Meeting sponsored a number of symposia including Advances in Supramolecular Chemistry, Biological Mass Spectrometry and Proteomics, Chemical Education, Chemistry and Technology for the 21st Century, Food Chemistry – A Myriad of Applications, Surface Chemistry, and Towards the Ideal Synthesis. A series of workshops were also offered by Career Services. Overall there were 379 oral and poster presentations in 32 sessions. The Exposition included 22 vendors and academic institutions.

Honored at the Awards Banquet was the winner of the 2003 Midwest Award for Outstanding Achievements in Chemistry (sponsored by the St. Louis Local Section), **Prof. Kristen Bowman-James**, Department of Chemistry, University of Kansas. Her presentation entitled “Anion Coordination Chemistry” was delivered prior to the reception and banquet. Also recognized was **Mr. Eugene Erickson**, Lincoln Senior High School, Sioux Falls, South Dakota, who was the recipient of the 2003 Midwest Regional Award for High School Chemistry Teaching. His address, “Always Encourage, Never Discourage” was included as part of the Chemical Education program on Friday morning. Finally, a special ACS Salute to Excellence Award was presented to **Prof. Emeritus John E. Bauman, Jr.**, in recognition of his many years of service as Secretary of the Midwest Regional Meeting Steering Committee and in tribute to his contributions to the American Chemical Society at many levels.
